## COACHING REPORT

We are pleased to provide the coaching report for the 2025-2026 Season.

The ATTA Coaching Team consists of the following coaches:

Based in Edmonton are coaches Kenny Li, and Ling Wang.

Based in Calgary is coach Phillip Xie.

- Also with our coaching team is coaching advisor, Coach Shu Ying Li from Edmonton to assist with all areas of our training program;
- As well, we engage assistant coaches to work with us in the training programs. They are Will Mak, and Jeremy Li in Calgary, and Anthony Chen in Edmonton.

Since our last report at the ATTA's AGM on June 6, 2025, our coaching team continued to work diligently through the training season to provide training and coaching for juniors of the Provincial Team Training Program in both Edmonton and Calgary.

In July 2025, Alberta juniors achieved outstanding results from the 2025 Canadian Table Tennis Championships. After more than four years away from the national stage team event, Team Alberta has made a triumphant return with results as follows:

year for the first time, and they have demonstrated promising developments in their skills at the national stage.

We would like to express our heartfelt gratitude to the parents, supporters, and sponsors who made this success possible.

Other than regular training when we begin the season in September 2025, we have completed the Winter Camp in December. The Spring Camp will follow at the end of March this year. We will be running the summer camp in the beginning of July with intensified training to help our juniors prepare for the 2026 Canadian Championships.

On December 6<sup>th</sup> 2025, we completed our first round of tryout for Team Alberta in Calgary with 50 juniors participated. This is a record turn out in the province's history for a tryout. The second round of tryout will be in Edmonton in March 2026.

We look forward to our juniors' team performance at the Canadian Western Open tournament in June this year, when they will compete with players from the 4 western provinces and 3 territories.

We are very proud of the growing progress of our young provincial team, and deeply appreciate the recognition of our work by team parents who have put their trust in our coaching, and been tirelessly supporting our training program.

In planning ahead, our coaching team shall continue with the ongoing progress such as:

- Continue to provide competitive level coaching, and quality training in our programs.
- Initiate and assist in providing more opportunities for table tennis events in our province, and training activities, for junior players in Alberta.
- Continue the development of younger Junior Hopes Program players with our long-term development program.
- Promote and provide opportunities for more women and girls involvement in the sport, and continue to open to gender-diverse, and ethnic diverse young players, in the sport of table tennis.

We believe these plans continued to be very important to the future of table tennis in Alberta.
